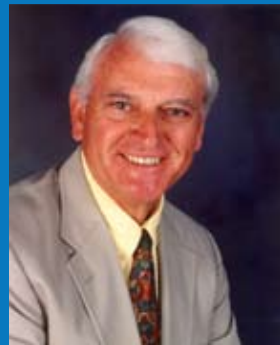

HONOR FLIGHT FOR WORLD WAR II VETERANS

James Heaberlin grew up in Beckley, West Virginia. He attended West Virginia University (WVU), receiving a BA in History in 1960, and a ROTC commission in the Army.

Jim was a helicopter pilot and served in the Fulda Gap along the Iron Curtain in West Germany, and then as the Brigade Helicopter Pilot patrolling the Berlin Wall. In 1964 Jim began a fifteen month tour in Vietnam commanding 8 Huey gunships, and subsequently left the Army.

He returned to WVU for an MBA in 1967, married JoAnn and moved to Pittsburg, PA starting a banking career with Mellon Bank, and subsequently the First National bank of Crown Point, IN. Jim continued his banking career in Ft. Collins until 1993. He and JoAnn now reside at Ptarmigan Country Club in Ft. Collins.

Jim will provide information about Honor Flight Northern Colorado, a National Program honoring World War II veterans by sending them on an all-expense paid trip to Washington, DC specifically to view the new monument dedicated to them.
